These topics were offered for discussion as they represented the opportunities that arose from the various phases of research. They were presented in three themes of housing, community and wellbeing and teams chose which they would work on.

A place to call home - Opportunities to invigorate the development of new specialist housing, and optimise existing mainstream housing, to deliver the right homes for older people, in the right places at the right price.

- 1. What opportunities are there to develop pathway/step-down housing services to relieve pressure on the NHS and social care?
- 2. What opportunities are there to provide accessible (not only online), holistic and locally-based advice, information and support to older people and their families/carers on housing and related issues?
- 3. What opportunities are there to improve the provision of timely, preventative home adaptations to elderly people ageing in place?
- 4. What opportunities are there to develop housing with care facilities for older people in Cornwall?
- 5. What opportunities are there to help those older people living in sub-standard living conditions to improve, and then maintain, their homes?
- 6. What opportunities are there to develop exciting and attractive, but future-proofed, housing that older people will want to move into?
- 7. What opportunities are there to bring together older people with spare rooms and low income workers looking for affordable housing, for mutual benefit?
- 8. What opportunities are there to develop dementia-friendly housing and communities?
- 9. What opportunities are there to encourage and facilitate co-housing and self-build projects?
