

Extra Care area profiles





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In Cornwall we face significant demographic, social and financial challenges over the coming years. Our population is increasing and ageing, as people are living longer, but often in poor health with disabilities. There are stark disparities in outcomes between areas of affluence and deprivation, often no more than a few miles apart.

Cornwall Council is committed to ensuring that high quality, sustainable accommodation with care is available across the county for older and disabled people.

A long term strategic objective of the Council is to move away from traditional social care service responses, by reducing the number of people receiving institutional forms of care, towards a range of accommodation and services that enable and support people to live independently in their own home.

To progress this at scale and pace the Council is seeking a strategic partner(s) to develop Extra Care Housing in our priority areas of need. The priority areas are:

- Camborne/Redruth

- Falmouth/Penryn


There are several bus stops and a bus station in Bude with services running through Mid and North West Cornwall and some parts of Devon.

The Looe and Liskeard area contains fifteen parishes; Dobwalls and Trewidland, Duloe, Lanreath, Lansallos, Liskeard, Looe, Menheniot, Morval, Pelynt, St Cleer, St Keyne, St Martin-by-Looe, St Neot, St Pinnock, and Warleggan. The area extends from Bodmin Moor in the north to Looe on the south coast. Looe and Liskeard are the two key towns in the area with the remaining area containing many smaller rural settlements.











Looe has several bus stops that link the town to Liskeard and Plymouth. Liskeard operates bus services throughout Cornwall and to Plymouth and London.

The A38 is the main route from Looe and Liskeard and links the towns to Plymouth, the M5 Exeter, and Bristol. Looe has a direct train line to Liskeard railway station which is part of the main London Paddington to Penzance line. Looe and Liskeard are approximately 27 and 35 miles from Cornwall Airport Newquay.


There are several bus stops throughout Wadebridge with services running to nearby Cornish towns.

The area borders with Devon to the east and apart from the two towns (Launceston and Callington), the area is largely rural and sparsely populated.

There are bus services operating throughout Callington and Launceston linking the towns with Cornwall, Plymouth and South Devon.



Priority area 6: Bodmin


Q Character




Area classification (2011)
